<p>✓ Own home or rent from a private landlord.</p> <p>Eligible customers are all those awarded:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Pension Credit or;</li> <li>✓ income-related Employment and Support Allowance that includes a work-related activity or support component (this includes contribution based ESA customers in the support group who get an income related top up because they automatically qualify for the enhanced disability premium payable with income related ESA)</li> </ul> <p>And those awarded:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Income Support or;</li> <li>✓ income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, or;</li> <li>✓ income-related Employment and Support Allowance in the assessment phase (first 13 weeks of the claim)</li> </ul> <p>Who must also have one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ a pensioner premium. or;</li> <li>✓ a disability or severe disability premium, or;</li> <li>✓ an award of child tax credit that also includes an element for a disabled, or severely disabled child or young person, or;</li> <li>✓ a child under the age of five living</li> </ul>	<p>The provision of the HTW Funding is intended to provide financial assistance to vulnerable people with a cold- and/or damp-related illness, when:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ they were not able to fund measures themselves, they did not qualify for statutory grants and insufficient funds are available from other sources, and/or</li> <li>✓ their health condition dictated that measures were urgent and that it would be detrimental to their health to wait for installation through statutory schemes even if eligible or,</li> <li>✓ they were in hospital and unable to return home until heating and/or hot water were available in their property (such as bed blocking), therefore the situation was regarded as an emergency.</li> </ul> <p>It is expected that all clients will already have been asked to make a contribution, where possible, towards the cost of measures.</p> <p>Illnesses that fit into the following categories will be considered as eligible for HTW Funding assistance.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Respiratory disease (for example, COPD, emphysema, chronic bronchitis, severe asthma)</li> <li>✓ Cardiovascular disease (for example, heart disease and stroke)</li> <li>✓ Diabetes (particularly type 1)</li> </ul>	<p>Receipt of at least one of the following benefits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ At least 70 years old</li> </ul> <p><b>OR</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Council tax benefit</li> <li>✓ Housing benefit</li> <li>✓ Income support</li> <li>✓ Income-based job seekers allowance</li> <li>✓ Income-related employment and support allowance</li> <li>✓ Attendance allowance</li> <li>✓ Disability living allowance</li> <li>✓ War disablement pension which includes either a mobility supplement or constant attendance allowance</li> <li>✓ Disablement pension which includes constant attendance allowance</li> <li>✓ State pension credit</li> </ul> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p>Receipt of at least one of the following credits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Child tax credit where the relevant income is £16,190 or less</li> <li>✓ Working tax credit where the relevant income is £16,190 or less</li> </ul>	<p>Receipt of at least one of the following benefits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ <b><u>state pension credit</u></b></li> </ul> <p><b>OR</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ <b><u>child tax credit</u></b> and has a relevant income below £16,190 (where "relevant income" has the same meaning as in Part 1 of the Tax Credits Act 2002);</li> <li>✓ <b><u>income-related employment and support allowance</u></b>, which must include a work-related activity or support component, <b><u>and</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) has parental responsibility for a child under the age of five who ordinarily resides with that member; <b><u>or</u></b></li> <li>b) is in receipt of a <b><u>qualifying component</u></b>;</li> </ol> </li> <li>✓ <b><u>income-based job seeker's allowance</u></b> and -           <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) has parental responsibility for a child under the age of five who ordinarily resides with that member; <b><u>or</u></b></li> <li>b) is in receipt of a <b><u>qualifying component</u></b>;</li> </ol> </li> <li>✓ <b><u>income support</u></b> and -           <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) has parental responsibility for a child under the age of five who ordinarily resides with that member; <b><u>or</u></b></li> <li>b) is in receipt of a <b><u>qualifying component</u></b>;</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
